BACHELOR OF COMMISSIONER SCIENCE

Upon completing Commissioner Basic Training, this is the first level of Commissioner College focusing on improving unit service (For Unit Commissioners or others who have not previously attended college).



MASTER OF COMMISSIONER SCIENCE

This course focuses on continuing your education in learning how to better serve units. It will provide tools and techniques necessary to provide “Lifesaving” methods. There are also courses intended for District or Assistant District and Roundtable Commissioners geared toward learning more about the administrative methods needed to excel as commissioner.

DOCTOR OF COMMISSIONER SCIENCE

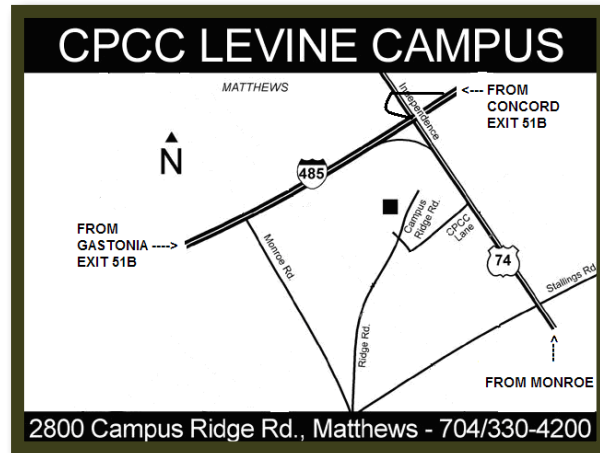
The final step in completing the traditional commissioner coursework. Sessions will assist the commissioners in writing their Thesis or Project.
